
Welcome to the Adopt-a-Float program! We are looking forward to having you join us as we watch the floats on their journey through the ocean.

Floats of the Month!

We have had five floats launched (over two expeditions) from the RV Sikuliaq off the coast of Alaska and Typhoon Merbok has hit the region fueled by abnormally high Sea Surface Temperatures (SST) - https://theconversation.com/typhoon-merbok-fueled-by-unusually-warm-pacific-ocean-pounded-alaskas-vulnerable-coastal-communities-at-a-critical-time-190898. And if you check out Soccer Mom (#5906531) adopted by Acton Boxborough Regional High School, you can see the increase in SST. Look at floats by Hurricane Kay off the California west coast or by Hurricane Fiona by Puerto Rico and see what you can find.
